Good Afternoon,

I wanted to take this time to give you another update on the happenings here at our Little Sisters Home. I hope this finds everyone doing well and staying safe from the virus. We continue to pray for our families and residents so they may stay safe and healthy during this difficult time.

I know as our visiting restrictions continue it is difficult on everyone. Please know that we are continuing to do the best we can while caring for the residents. We are entertaining them, laughing with them, caring for them and most importantly, we love them. I encourage you to reach out and set up a time to talk with them on the phone, face time or skype. I am happy to report that we continue to have no residents exhibit any symptoms of the coronavirus. As I mentioned last week, we had one employee test positive for COVID-19. This employee has not been back to our Home as of yet, and neither have those employees who worked with her. Of those who worked with her, all of the employees who have been tested, their tests have come back negative.

We are continuing to screen all employees at the beginning of their shift, prior to allowing them access to the units. This screening includes taking their temperature and asking them a series of questions, specifically asking if they have experienced any of the signs and symptoms of the virus. We are also continuing to assess each resident every shift for respiratory symptoms, fever and other signs of the virus.

We have created a temporary unit that we are calling our "NEST". It stands for our New Emergent Special Treatment unit. It is located on the third floor and is completely blocked off from the rest of the unit. Temporary walls have been constructed to create this unit which will be used for any of our residents who begin exhibiting signs and symptoms of the virus. At this time we have the capacity for 6 residents. The NEST is prepared to have residents at any time, and will be staffed separately from any other unit. We will have staff dedicated specifically to this unit who will provide care for the residents living there.

Please know that we will continue to work every day to keep your loved ones safe and happy. We take each day as they come and hope to continue our mission of caring for our residents.
