Good Afternoon,

We continue to stay busy here at St. Paul's Home. Residents are not routinely tested for COVID but we are happy to report that no Residents have tested positive or shown any signs or symptoms of COVID as of today. We are so thankful we have managed to keep the virus away from our residents and keep them safe over the past several months.

Outside visitations will continue on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9-11am and 4-6pm. The weather remains our biggest obstacle because we are still required to hold the visits outside. If we are experiencing inclement weather (too hot, too cold or raining) please understand that we will have to cancel the visits. We will monitor the weather and make a decision one hour before the scheduled visits (8am or 3pm) if we need to cancel.

Please note that not all staff monitors during the visits are from the nursing department, so we ask that we all refrain from discussing private medical information during these visits. Please contact the home at another time if you have questions or would like to discuss something regarding the care of your loved one. We want this to be a time for you to enjoy with your family member or friend while visits will still be allowed.
