We are again happy to report that we have had no positive COVID test results for any of our staff or Residents during this past week. We will continue our staff testing regime next week and test all staff as part of the surveillance testing required by the Ohio Department of Health. Only those Residents showing signs or symptoms of COVID will be tested.

As many of you may have heard, Governor DeWine announced yesterday that we will soon be able to open for inside visits. There will be specific guidelines and rules, of course, but we are happy to be able to have visitors back at Little Sisters. Once the guidelines are available, we will work on our plan for our visits. We will continue to take reservations when we transition to the inside visits and will have stations available for 2 visitors for each Resident. More details will follow as we understand the rules associated with coming inside the Home.

September is quickly coming to a close, and our Monthly Mystery Raffle Basket ticket will be drawn next week. One luck winner will be awarded this amazing basket – last minute tickets still available on the website if you are interested!
