Dear Families and Friends,

As you are all aware, we continue to do weekly testing as is required by the Ohio Department of Health and Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). This week two of our employees tested positive for COVID-19. Neither employee had any Resident contact. One of the employees has not been at work since October 9<sup>th</sup>, except to come in and be tested, and the other is a new employee who had only been here for testing and orientation. They have both been removed from the schedule and will not be in the Home for at least the next 14 days. After speaking with both employees and tracing their actions at the Home, other employees who had close contact with either of them have also been removed from the schedule and asked to self-quarantine at home.

Due to the positive test results our Home is now under “Outbreak” testing. All Residents have been tested today as a precautionary measure. This information was discussed with the Residents today as the nursing staff completed the testing. The test completed was a swab of the anterior nares, where the swab only enters the nostril approximately an inch and less invasive than a nasopharyngeal test. These are the tests we have been using since July.

As always, please feel free to contact us if you have any questions or concerns. We are continuing to be vigilant and are doing everything to keep our residents and your loved ones safe.
