In the past week we have had an employee test positive for COVID. It was a new employee who has had no contact with any Residents, and it was discovered on a pre-employment test.

Although we were looking forward to the possibility of visitations, this will delay us opening for inside visits for a couple weeks. As per Ohio Department of Health, we must be able to go 14 days without anyone testing positive so that we may open up for inside visits for all of you.

We have continued to remain vigilant, wearing PPE and maintaining good infection control in the Home. All Residents tested negative again this week. We are happy that all Residents remain negative for COVID and are discussing ways to conduct activities where we may have a little added socialization for the residents while maintaining good infection control practices and social distancing.

We are in discussions with our pharmacy to determine best practices for administering vaccines for any new Residents or staff who would like to receive it. We are encouraged that we will be able to continue to offer it to those who need it.
