To our supportive friends and family,

In Spring of 2020 we asked for your help replacing our 45 year old boiler system. Because of the expense and enormity of this project, we split it into two phases. We began to replace two of the three boilers and then protecting our home and Residents against COVID took priority.

Because of this and supply chain delays, the second phase of the Boiler Project was delayed. In this New Year we are going to be able to focus on completing this necessary project. Phase 2 consists of replacing the third and final boiler. The other aspect of this second phase is the installation of two instantaneous water heaters that will provide hot water to the building without running the boilers in the summer months, new pumps that will reduce electrical utility usage, and the control system will be digitally upgraded for easier maintenance.

This upgrade to our boiler system will prolong the life of the new boilers significantly and provide substantial savings in natural gas and utility costs. Total project costs are estimated to be around \$670,000 and because of your support as well as some grants we have been able to raise \$33,800 to offset the cost of this required project. In these past two years COVID has cost us more than we expected and we have been unable to hold any in person fundraisers in these past two years. As always, without you we would not be able to provide a safe and comfortable environment for our Residents.
